CHRISTMAS MASS SEATING AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS

We are very much looking forward to gathering to celebrate Christmas this year!

To accommodate an expected increase in attendance for our Christmas Masses and maintain a safe environment for our parishioners and their guests given the continued presence of COVID-19, please note the specific protocols outlined below for Masses on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. These have been put in place to provide safety, flexibility, and options for all our parishioners and their guests during this very special occasion. Please use your judgement to decide which Mass you prefer to attend.

Seating for all Masses will be first come, first served — no reservations needed. When the sanctuary reaches capacity and to prevent overcrowding, the outside doors will be closed. Please plan to arrive early for all Masses as we may be unable to accommodate late arrivals and remember there are multiple Masses on both days. We ask that you practice reasonable distancing between family groups within the pews with the help of our ushers. For those who prefer not to attend inside the sanctuary, we will be broadcasting the sound outside to the front patio and parking lot with outdoor Eucharistic Ministers for the 6:30pm Mass on Christmas Eve. Live streams of each Mass will also be available.

On December 12 at noon Mass we honored *Our Lady of Guadalupe* with a lovely and mystical ceremony. The celebration started with the procession of the image of the Virgen, with candles and bouquets of roses, carried by a group of eighth graders. The Mass was accompanied by Mexican songs and ended with a prayer to the Virgen Mary. Special thanks to Vivian and Steve Amato who dedicated their time and talents to assemble a beautiful altar, and to David Schmidt and Francis Kim for the wonderful music.

In the narthex, after all masses, we had a small market which showcased Christmas products made by hand by a group of Latino women trained by Nanuu, a not for profit organization that supports underprivileged immigrant Latino women in the Bronx, to overcome their challenges by developing new ways of generating income. 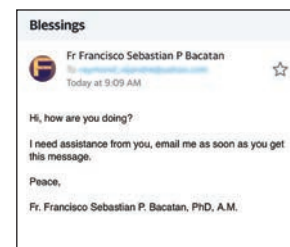
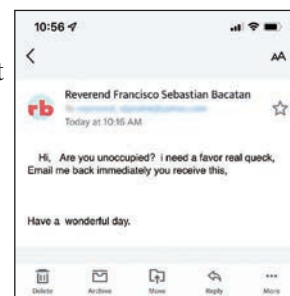

- **"Hi, Are you unoccupied?"** and include my name, "Father Sebastian," in the from line of the message.
- An email entitled **Blessings** is a Christmas Scam.
- An email entitled **New Deposit Information**, asking to change bank information for the next paycheck.

Please delete and/or block the email address: frfranciscosebastianpbacatan@gmail.com. This is a well-crafted and targeted attack on the Church across the country which has hit our Archdiocese of New York again. The messages are "spoofed" fakes that should not be responded to or taken seriously by anyone. The best defense against this sort of scam is to raise awareness in the community and DO NOT respond or open any worrying attachments. It is Diocesan policy that no priest or staff within the Diocese request donations in the form of gift cards, PayPal, MoneyGram, etc. I ask that you please DELETE THE EMAIL and call the parish office. Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES should you ever respond to these scams.
