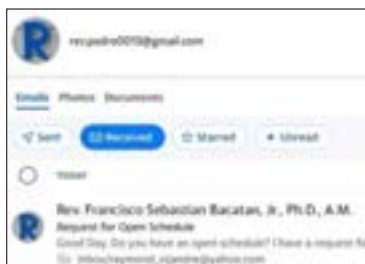
Please DO NOT donate any perishable food (other than frozen turkeys). NO items in glass jars.

During the season of Advent, Devotions, along with the traditional lighting of the Advent candles, will include the procession of “Nativity figures” at the beginning of the Mass.



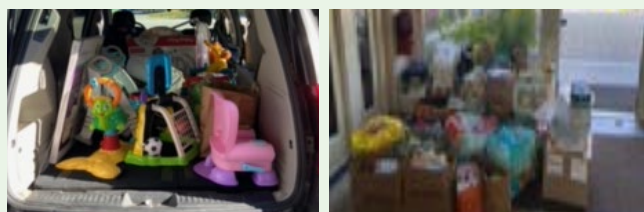

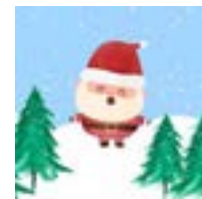
