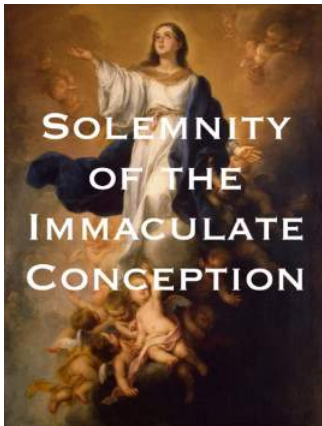

Lighting of Advent Candle and Building the Manger

Advent (from advenire in Latin or "to come"), the beginning of the Liturgical Year, is the season consisting of the four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up to the celebration of Christmas.

The Advent season is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming at the end of time and also to the anniversary of the Lord's birth on Christmas.

The Church of Saint Pius X Advent Devotion will include the traditional lighting of the Advent candles as well as the procession of "Nativity figures" at the beginning of Mass.

Each Sunday of Advent, an assigned family, in procession with the Liturgical Ministers, will bring to the altar nativity figures that will be placed in the manger before the Advent candle is lit. The assigned family will return to their seats after the procession. During the Offertory of the Mass, the family will bring the gifts to the altar.

We would like to invite families to participate in this Advent devotion. Please sign up by clicking on the link below if your family is interested in participating. The Masses for the Advent devotions will include the 5:00 pm Saturday Vigil and the 8:00 am, 9:15 am, 10:30 am, and 12:00 noon Masses on Sunday.
