^{*} Canon #874 of Church law states a Sponsor: (1) cannot be a parent but can be a sibling; (2) must be at least 16 years of age; (3) must be a Catholic who has received the Most Holy Sacrament of the Eucharist and been confirmed; and (4) must be willing to take an active role in the candidate's faith journey. Sponsors should communicate with their candidate about their faith journeys on a regular basis.
