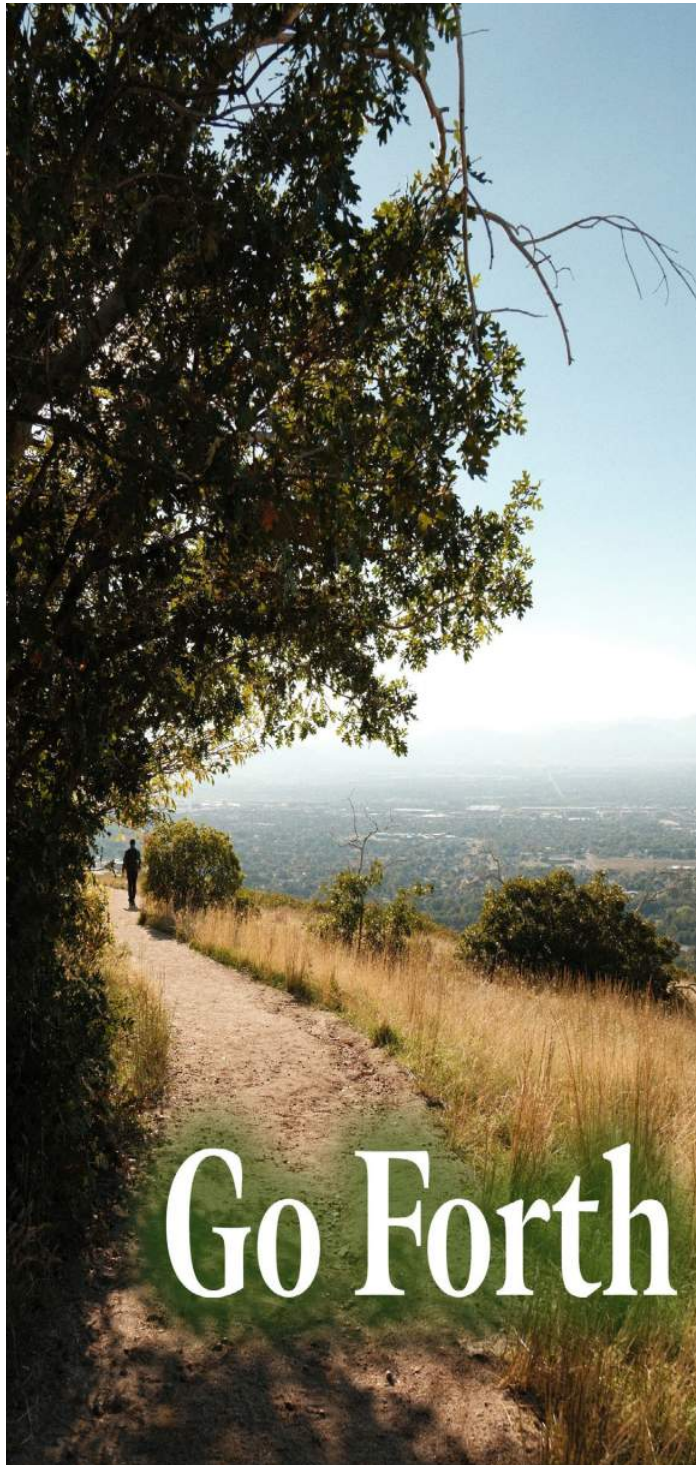

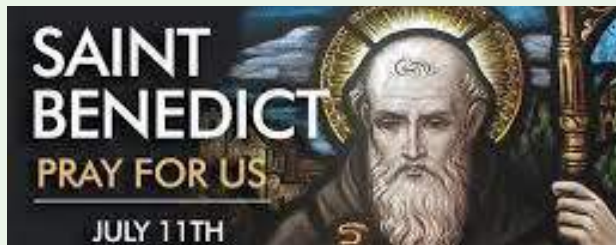

Dear Padre

July 6, 2025

At Mass during the Our Father, should we hold hands, lift our hands up, or keep our hands to ourselves?

Among many ancient religions, it was common to extend one's hands toward heaven while praying. This practice has continued in the Mass, where the rubrics indicate that the priest should extend his hands at certain points, including during the Our Father. The celebrant represents all the people with this gesture. The deacon is expressly forbidden to hold his hands up in prayer. There is no particular gesture assigned to the rest of the congregation. Some may be holding hands, some lifting their hands, some standing with arms crossed.

The variety of postures is not a problem in itself. The problem is when people become distracted or judgmental of others. As a rule of thumb, I suggest doing what the rest of the congregation does. As stated in the "Order of the Mass," written by the Bishops' Committee on the Liturgy in 2003, "The people are called as members of an organic whole, not as disparate individuals. A Christian assembly that worships 'with one heart and mind' (Acts 4:32) naturally moves toward and consciously chooses a common posture as a sign of its unity. Such common posture 'both expresses and fosters the intention and spiritual attitude of the participants'" (28). The gestures at Mass are not as important as the essence of the Mass, and part of that essence is our unity in the body of Christ. ●

Volunteers Needed for the 2025-2026 School Year to Spread the Good News!

Our Religious Education is so grateful for the generosity and dedication of volunteers who contribute in various ways in nurturing the hearts and minds of the young members of our parish. If you feel called to serve as a catechist, catechist aide or hall monitor, below is a brief description of their responsibilities:

- **Catechists** are responsible for teaching and guiding students in their faith formation, following the curriculum prescribed by the Archdiocese of New York. This role requires a strong knowledge and commitment to the faith, the ability to communicate religious teachings effectively. Diocesan training sessions are available through the ArchNYLAB catechist training portal.
- **Catechist Aides** work closely with the teacher during religious education classes. They assist in preparing materials, setting up the classroom, implementing class projects and ensuring a smooth flow of activities. They help maintain discipline and order in the classroom, check class attendance, and whenever needed, accompany students who may need to go out of the classroom (e.g. to use the restroom).
- **Hall Monitors** ensure the safety of students and staff while classes are in session. They monitor entrances, hallways, and common areas to maintain order and minimize disruptions. They note and, if necessary, attend to any unusual patterns, such as late arrivals or early departures of students. In case of emergency, they assist in evacuations and follow established protocols.

All volunteers will need to submit to a background check and complete the Safe Environment Training Program prescribed by the Archdiocese of New York.
