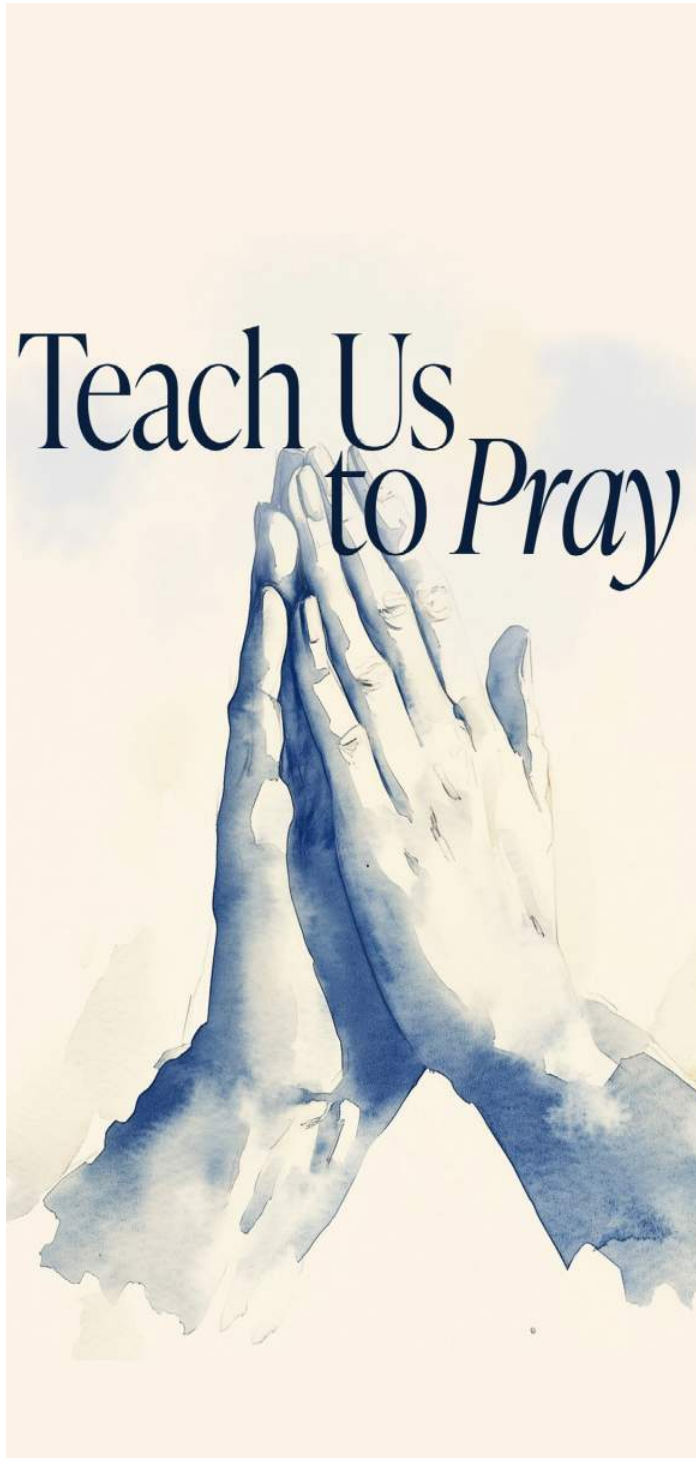

***Who wrote the Lord's Prayer? I
know the Lord's Prayer comes
from Scripture, but who
composed it as we say it today?***

When the disciples asked the Lord to teach them to pray, he taught them the prayer we know as the Our Father. Two versions of that prayer appear in the Gospels of Matthew and Luke. The version used in the Church's liturgies is derived from Matthew 6:9–13. In fact, citing St. Thomas Aquinas' *Summa Theologiae*, the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* calls the Lord's Prayer the "most perfect of prayers" (2774), teaching us not only what things to pray for in our prayer but also in what order, or priority, we should desire them. It is at the heart of every individual and communal prayer.

We pray the Our Father, bearing in mind and heart the intimate relationship we have with our God as sons and daughters by adoption through our baptism. The specific wording of our prayers is a work in progress. What we think of as the final wording is that which the Church has approved and makes the most sense for prayer as a community. What is most important is that the substance of the prayer reflects the same matter the Lord used in the prayer. ●

WHO IS ST. PHOEBE, AND WHY DO WE CELEBRATE HER?

St. Phoebe is remembered as the first woman deacon in the early Church. In Romans 16:1-2, St. Paul introduces her as a deacon of the church in Cenchreae and commends her to the Christian community in Rome.

A woman of deep faith and courage, Phoebe answered God's call to serve during a time of persecution. She earned the trust of Paul, who depended on her to handle communications with the ecclesial community in Rome. Her legacy reminds us that from the Church's beginning, women have used their God-given gifts to lead, serve, and strengthen the faith community. We celebrate St. Phoebe to honor her and the continuing role of women in the life of the Church.

Religious Education

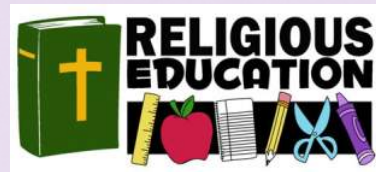
Volunteers Needed for the 2025-2026 School Year to Spread the Good News!

Our Religious Education is so grateful for the generosity and dedication of volunteers who contribute in various ways in nurturing the hearts and minds of the young members of our parish. If you feel called to serve as a catechist, catechist aide or hall monitor, below is a brief description of their responsibilities:

- **Catechists** are responsible for teaching and guiding students in their faith formation, following the curriculum prescribed by the Archdiocese of New York. This role requires a strong knowledge and commitment to the faith, the ability to communicate religious teachings effectively. Diocesan training sessions are available through the ArchNYLAB catechist training portal.
- **Catechist Aides** work closely with the teacher during religious education classes. They assist in preparing materials, setting up the classroom, implementing class projects and ensuring a smooth flow of activities. Volunteers Needed:
 - 1st Grade - 2
 - 2nd Grade - 2
 - 5th Grade - 1
 - 7th Grade - 1
 - 8th Grade - 2
- **Hall Monitors** ensure the safety of students and staff while classes are in session. They monitor entrances, hallways, and common areas to maintain order and minimize disruptions. They note and, if necessary, attend to any unusual patterns, such as late arrivals or early departures of students. In case of emergency, they assist in evacuations and follow established protocols.

All volunteers will need to submit to a background check and complete the Safe Environment Training Program prescribed by the Archdiocese of New York.

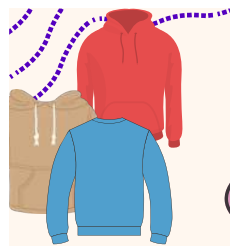

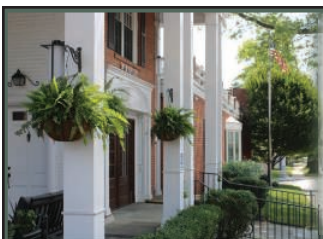
