REV. PETER M. DONOHUE, OSA, PhD
32nd President
Villanova University

Donohue of the 12PM Mass at the
St. Pius X Church

Father Peter Donohue, President at Villanova University, will explore how the teachings of St. Augustine shaped the life and leadership of Pope Leo XIV. The talk highlights his Augustinian roots and how they influenced his vision for the Church and commitment to spiritual renewal.

Father Peter Donohue, born in Bronx, NY, and raised in Royal Oak, Michigan, earned his BA with a concentration in theatre and communication arts from Villanova University in 1975, and was ordained an Augustinian priest in 1979. He holds advanced degrees in theatre and theology, including a PhD from the University of Illinois, where he also taught and received honors for outstanding teaching.

A tenured professor at Villanova, he chaired the Department of Theatre from 1992 to 2006, directing numerous productions and earning multiple Barrymore Award nominations and one Barrymore Award for Outstanding Direction of a Musical.

Since becoming Villanova's 32nd president in 2006, Fr. Donohue has led major strategic initiatives, a record-breaking fundraising campaign, extensive campus improvements, and efforts to enhance academic reputation and student opportunities—all while reinforcing the University's Augustinian, Catholic mission.

St. Phoebe's Day Celebration - Sunday, September 7 at Noon Mass

WOMEN'S ROLE IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH - FROM EARLY CHRISTIANITY TO VATICAN II

From early Christianity through the post-Tridentine period (around 1500), women played influential roles in Church governance and religious life. Figures like St. Phoebe, St. Clare of Assisi, St. Catherine of Siena, and St. Teresa of Avila shaped the Church's mission and often advised bishops and popes.

However, between the Council of Trent (1545–1563) and Vatican II (1962–1965), women were largely sidelined, expected to be obedient, self-sacrificing, and focused on family life. Laywomen were rarely trusted with leadership, and religious life was seen as their only spiritual path. Religious orders like the Ursulines, Daughters of Charity, and Sisters of Mercy flourished and led efforts in education, healthcare, and service to the poor.

Although excluded from formal leadership, many Catholic women shaped the Church through their writings, devotion, and tireless service—a legacy that still inspires today.

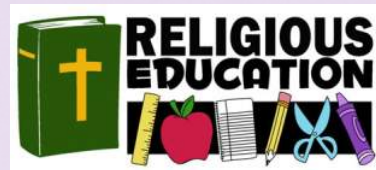
Volunteers Needed for the 2025-2026 School Year to Spread the Good News!

Our Religious Education is so grateful for the generosity and dedication of volunteers who contribute in various ways in nurturing the hearts and minds of the young members of our parish. If you feel called to serve as a catechist, catechist aide or hall monitor, below is a brief description of their responsibilities:

- **Catechists** are responsible for teaching and guiding students in their faith formation, following the curriculum prescribed by the Archdiocese of New York. This role requires a strong knowledge and commitment to the faith, the ability to communicate religious teachings effectively. Diocesan training sessions are available through the ArchNYLAB catechist training portal.
- **Catechist Aides** work closely with the teacher during religious education classes. They assist in preparing materials, setting up the classroom, implementing class projects and ensuring a smooth flow of activities. Volunteers Needed:
 - 1st Grade - 2
 - 2nd Grade - 2
 - 5th Grade - 1
 - 7th Grade - 1
 - 8th Grade - 2
- **Hall Monitors** ensure the safety of students and staff while classes are in session. They monitor entrances, hallways, and common areas to maintain order and minimize disruptions. They note and, if necessary, attend to any unusual patterns, such as late arrivals or early departures of students. In case of emergency, they assist in evacuations and follow established protocols.

All volunteers will need to submit to a background check and complete the Safe Environment Training Program prescribed by the Archdiocese of New York.

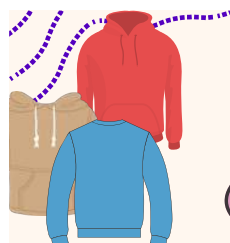

Sometimes after Mass, I go to the late service at a "Bible church" with the rest of my family. Once a month, this church serves communion, but they make it clear that it is only as a memory of Jesus and the Last Supper, and that Jesus is not present at communion. Is it OK to receive this communion?

The Catholic understanding of Holy Communion includes not only the understanding of Communion as the Body and Blood of Christ, but it includes something more. Communion is a statement of belief and a statement of belonging. When Catholics participate in the sacrament, they are identifying with divinity as well as with the community of believers who are joined together in "one mind and in one spirit." It is an act of unity, a real "communion." Even though the Bible church clearly teaches a different theology of communion, it would seem to me that, for a Catholic, the fullest meaning and understanding of Communion is important and worth witnessing to. For this reason, I would refrain from participating in communion at the Bible church. Do so quietly and respectfully, because what is being celebrated is important; it just does not have the full meaning that you understand is necessary. ●

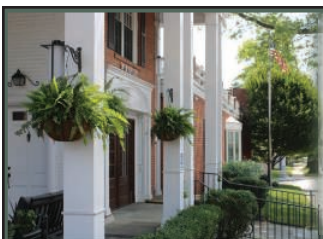
