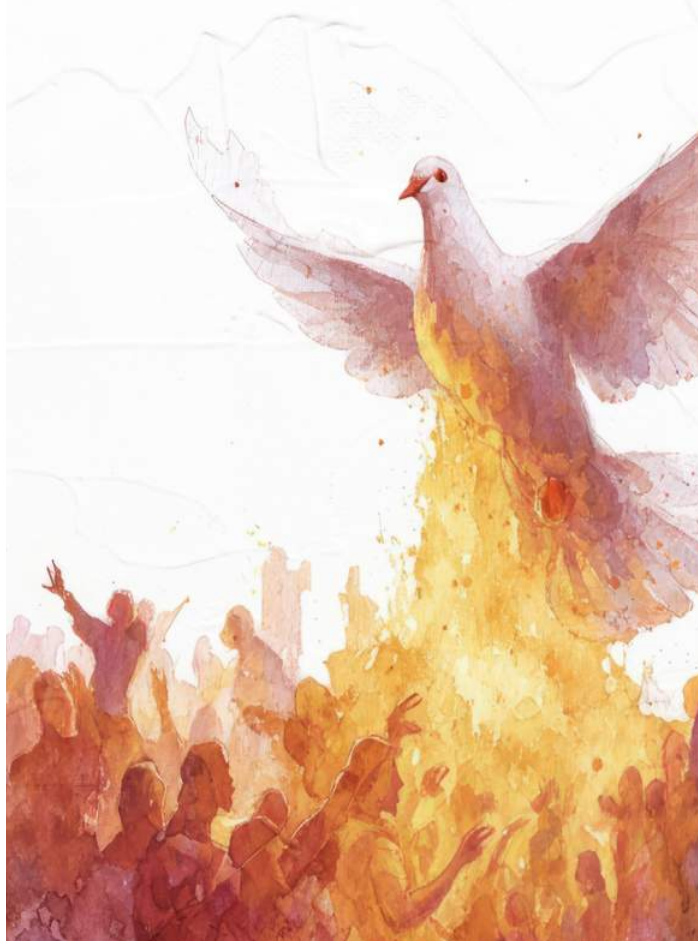

### *The Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary*

Pope Pius XII established this feast in 1954. But the Blessed Virgin Mary's queenship has roots in Scripture. At the Annunciation, Gabriel announced that Mary's Son would receive the throne of David and rule forever. At the Visitation, Elizabeth calls Mary "mother of my Lord." As in all the mysteries of Mary's life, she is closely associated with Jesus: Her queenship is a share in Jesus' kingship. We can also recall that in the Old Testament the mother of the king has great influence in court.

In the fourth century Saint Ephrem called Mary "Lady" and "Queen." Later Church fathers and doctors continued to use the title. Hymns of the 11th to 13th centuries address Mary as queen: "Hail, Holy Queen," "Hail, Queen of Heaven," "Queen of Heaven." The Dominican rosary and the Franciscan crown as well as numerous invocations in Mary's litany celebrate her queenship.

The feast is a logical follow-up to the Assumption, and is now celebrated on the octave day of that feast. In his 1954 encyclical *To the Queen of Heaven*, Pius XII points out that Mary deserves the title because she is Mother of God, because she is closely associated as the New Eve with Jesus' redemptive work, because of her preeminent perfection, and because of her intercessory power.

Father Peter Donohue, President at Villanova University, will explore how the teachings of St. Augustine shaped the life and leadership of Pope Leo XIV. The talk highlights his Augustinian roots and how they influenced his vision for the Church and commitment to spiritual renewal.

Father Peter Donohue, born in Bronx, NY, and raised in Royal Oak, Michigan, earned his BA with a concentration in theatre and communication arts from Villanova University in 1975, and was ordained an Augustinian priest in 1979. He holds advanced degrees in theatre and theology, including a PhD from the University of Illinois, where he also taught and received honors for outstanding teaching.

A tenured professor at Villanova, he chaired the Department of Theatre from 1992 to 2006, directing numerous productions and earning multiple Barrymore Award nominations and one Barrymore Award for Outstanding Direction of a Musical.

Since becoming Villanova's 32nd president in 2006, Fr. Donohue has led major strategic initiatives, a record-breaking fundraising campaign, extensive campus improvements, and efforts to enhance academic reputation and student opportunities—all while reinforcing the University's Augustinian, Catholic mission.

# SPX Celebrates Women in the Church

St. Phoebe's Day Celebration -  
Sunday, September 7 at Noon Mass

## WOMEN'S ROLE IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH - SYNOD OF SYNODALITY

The Synod on Synodality, launched by Pope Francis in 2021, seeks to renew the Church through greater inclusion and dialogue. A key topic raised is the possibility of restoring women deacons—a role present in the early Church. While no decision has been made, the report recognized broad interest and called for further study. The Synod has opened space for serious reflection on expanding women's roles in Church ministry.

Paragraph 60 of the Synod on Synodality affirms the equal dignity of women in the Church and calls for removing barriers to their full participation. It affirms that baptism gives men and women equal dignity but notes that women still face barriers to fully living their vocation and serving in the Church. It also reiterates that the question of women's access to the diaconate remains open and merits further discernment.

## Religious Education

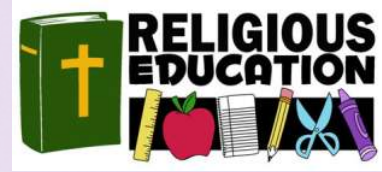
### *Volunteers Needed for the 2025-2026 School Year to Spread the Good News!*

Our Religious Education is so grateful for the generosity and dedication of volunteers who contribute in various ways in nurturing the hearts and minds of the young members of our parish. If you feel called to serve as a catechist, catechist aide or hall monitor, below is a brief description of their responsibilities:

- **Catechists** are responsible for teaching and guiding students in their faith formation, following the curriculum prescribed by the Archdiocese of New York. This role requires a strong knowledge and commitment to the faith, the ability to communicate religious teachings effectively. Diocesan training sessions are available through the ArchNYLAB catechist training portal.
- **Catechist Aides** work closely with the teacher during religious education classes. They assist in preparing materials, setting up the classroom, implementing class projects and ensuring a smooth flow of activities. Volunteers Needed:
  - **1st Grade - 2**
  - **2nd Grade - 2**
  - **5th Grade - 1**
  - **7th Grade - 1**
  - **8th Grade - 2**
- **Hall Monitors** ensure the safety of students and staff while classes are in session. They monitor entrances, hallways, and common areas to maintain order and minimize disruptions. They note and, if necessary, attend to any unusual patterns, such as late arrivals or early departures of students. In case of emergency, they assist in evacuations and follow established protocols.

All volunteers will need to submit to a background check and complete the Safe Environment Training Program prescribed by the Archdiocese of New York. **Assistants can also volunteer for a semester or on call.**

## Pastoral Care

The Ministry of Pastoral Care seeks to integrate the sick as well as homebound or hospitalized parishioners of the Church of Saint Pius X into the spiritual community and address their needs. Any adult Catholic who has received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation) who wishes to serve and is comfortable bringing Communion to the sick and/or elderly will be trained. 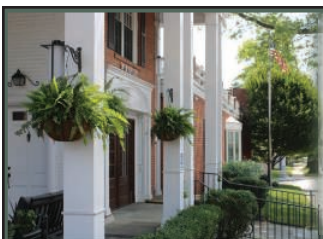
