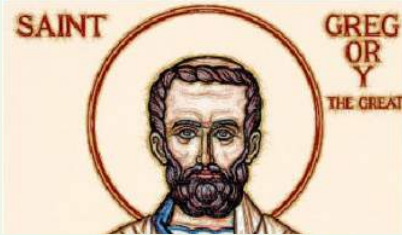

#### *St. Gregory the Great*

Saint Gregory the Great was the prefect of Rome before he was 30. After five years in office he resigned, founded six monasteries on his Sicilian estate, and became a Benedictine monk in his own home at Rome.

Ordained a priest, Gregory became one of the pope's seven deacons, and also served six years in the East as papal representative in Constantinople. He was recalled to become abbot, but at the age of 50 was elected pope by the clergy and people of Rome.

Gregory was direct and firm. He removed unworthy priests from office, forbade taking money for many services, emptied the papal treasury to ransom prisoners of the Lombards and to care for persecuted Jews and the victims of plague and famine. He was very concerned about the conversion of England, sending 40 monks from his own monastery. He is known for his reform of the liturgy, and for strengthening respect for doctrine. Whether he was largely responsible for the revision of "Gregorian" chant is disputed.

Saint Gregory the Great lived in a time of perpetual strife with invading Lombards and difficult relations with the East. When Rome itself was under attack, he interviewed the Lombard king.

His book, Pastoral Care, on the duties and qualities of a bishop, was read for centuries after his death. He described bishops mainly as physicians whose main duties were preaching and the enforcement of discipline. In his own down-to-earth preaching, Gregory was skilled at applying the daily Gospel to the needs of his listeners. Called "the Great," Gregory has been given a place with Augustine, Ambrose, and Jerome, as one of the four key doctors of the Western Church.

An Anglican historian has written: "It is impossible to conceive what would have been the confusion, the lawlessness, the chaotic state of the Middle Ages without the medieval papacy; and of the medieval papacy, the real father is Gregory the Great."

Father Peter Donohue, President at Villanova University, will explore how the teachings of St. Augustine shaped the life and leadership of Pope Leo XIV. The talk highlights his Augustinian roots and how they influenced his vision for the Church and commitment to spiritual renewal.

Father Peter Donohue, born in Bronx, NY, and raised in Royal Oak, Michigan, earned his BA with a concentration in theatre and communication arts from Villanova University in 1975, and was ordained an Augustinian priest in 1979. He holds advanced degrees in theatre and theology, including a PhD from the University of Illinois, where he also taught and received honors for outstanding teaching.

A tenured professor at Villanova, he chaired the Department of Theatre from 1992 to 2006, directing numerous productions and earning multiple Barrymore Award nominations and one Barrymore Award for Outstanding Direction of a Musical.

Since becoming Villanova's 32nd president in 2006, Fr. Donohue has led major strategic initiatives, a record-breaking fundraising campaign, extensive campus improvements, and efforts to enhance academic reputation and student opportunities—all while reinforcing the University's Augustinian, Catholic mission.

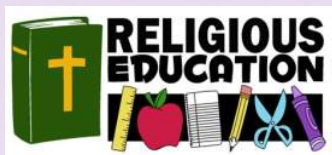

**Some important reminders and guidelines to help you and your child/children have a smooth start to the year:**

#### Traffic Pattern

Please enter the parking lot from Mamaroneck Road and leave by way of Secor Road in front of the Rectory. Each parent/guardian of a child in grades 1 through 4 should park his/her car in a parking space **(not handicapped or fire lane spaces)** and walk to and from the main entrance of the school building with his/her child. **Do not drive in front of the school entrance.** Drive slowly as children often run out into the parking lot. Please be mindful and courteous to other drivers.

#### Arrival Protocols

Parents of a child in grades 1 through 4 should walk their child to his/her classroom using the main entrance of the school **ONLY**. Children from grades 5 through 8 should remain in the school lobby until the Catechist arrives to escort them to their classroom. Students should not be in the classroom unless the Catechist is in the classroom.

#### Departure Protocols

Parents/guardians may come into the school building 10 minutes before dismissal time and wait in the Lobby except parents/guardians of children in grades 1 through 4 may go to the classroom at 5:00 pm and wait outside the door for dismissal.

## 2026 Mass Intentions

**The 2026 Mass Book is now available for reserving Mass Intentions.**

To ensure that there are weekend and Holy Day Mass Intentions available to parishioners throughout the year, sign up procedure are as follows:

At the beginning of the calendar year, each family may reserve up to 4 individual Mass intentions for weekend and Holy Day Masses (and an unlimited number of Mass intentions on weekdays and non-Holy Days and shared weekend Mass intentions) on a first come, first serve basis.

Thereafter, families will be able to reserve any remaining individual Sunday and Holy Day Mass intentions on a first come, first serve basis.

Mass intentions for the 5PM Saturday evening Mass and the Sunday 12PM Mass on the last weekend of each month may be allotted for shared Mass intentions. Shared Mass intentions will also be announced in the Bulletin and at the beginning of Mass.

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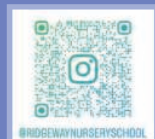
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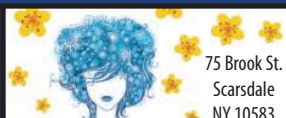
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
