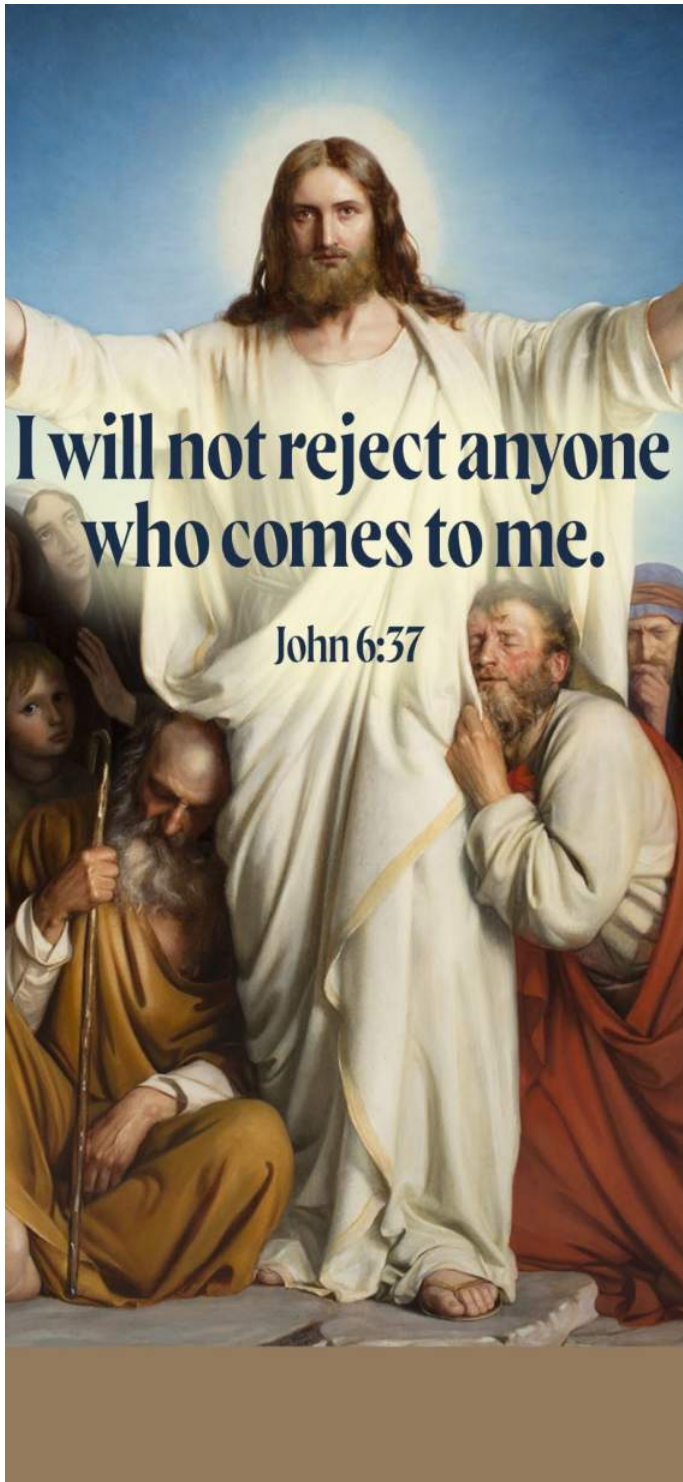

Church of Saint Pius X Luncheon for People with Differing Abilities

The Church of Saint Pius X once again hosted the Luncheon for People with Differing Abilities, on Saturday, October 18, 2025. Our parishioner volunteer crew set up the parish hall the night before; tables, chairs, place settings, and floral centerpieces. Guests started arriving at 11:00 AM the next morning, and were greeted and seated by our 8th grade Confirmation candidates. Over 80 guests from the Institutes of Applied Human Dynamics (IAHD), the Center for Family Support, and the New York Foundling residences in our area attended. At 12:00 noon, Fr. Sebastian said Mass, assisted by our 8th Grade lectors and altar servers. During this time our parish volunteer kitchen staff was preparing a hot meal, which consisted of a chicken casserole (made according to a time-tested parish recipe), homemade cranberry sauce, and a buttered dinner roll. Lunch immediately followed the Mass. The 8th graders first served a fruit cocktail cup, followed by the main course. For dessert the students served brownies and ice cream. After lunch, we had live music for all to enjoy, and dance to.

Our guests all had a great time, and thanked us for hosting them again. It was an enjoyable day for all. At the end of the event, each guest went home with a party favor gift bag, and surplus casseroles and brownies. After all were satisfied, we still had casseroles left. They were frozen and delivered to the Hope Community Services soup kitchen in New Rochelle, the following week. They were also very grateful that we included them as part of this event. A big thank you to all our parishioners that prepared and donated the casseroles, brownies, cranberry sauce, and monetary donations, and our 8th grade Confirmation candidates who served and helped the cleanup afterwards. Without your contributions, and effort we would not have been able to have such a successful event.

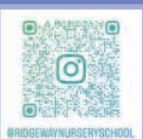

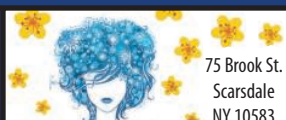
