7th Grade Pre-Confirmation Retreat

On Monday, April 13th, our 7th grade pre-confirmation class attended a retreat specifically designed for them. The presenter was Kevin Johnson, an adjunct instructor of theology and religious studies at Sacred Heart University. The theme of this retreat was “Come to me, and I will give you rest.” (Matthew 11:28). This retreat introduced the students to Christian prayer as a lived relationship with God, experienced in quiet attention, breath, and interior awareness. The students learned what gentle guided prayer is using breath and the sacred Name Yahweh. During the final session, the students were individually invited to discover that God’s presence can be encountered inwardly; in stillness, memory of love, and the quiet center, traditionally called the heart. At its conclusion, a pizza buffet was available in the Parish Hall for all to enjoy. Finally, the students received a simple breath prayer and blessing card for them to use at home. A special thank you to Ellen Aslanian, Kelly Myers, Aurelie Ferrara, and Fr. Rocky for their efforts in organizing and chaperoning this blessed event.

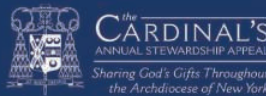
