

AFTER THE SERVICE



Please take any items you may have brought with you.



Use the sanitizing cloths at the end of the pews to clean all areas you have touched. Please take used cloths with you and dispose of them by throwing them in the trash bin in the Narthex.



You will be dismissed by pew or seating area. Follow the instructions of the greeter or usher.



Use only the designated exit doors.



Do not congregate in the Narthex or outside the church building.



Continue to wear your face covering until you exit the church building.

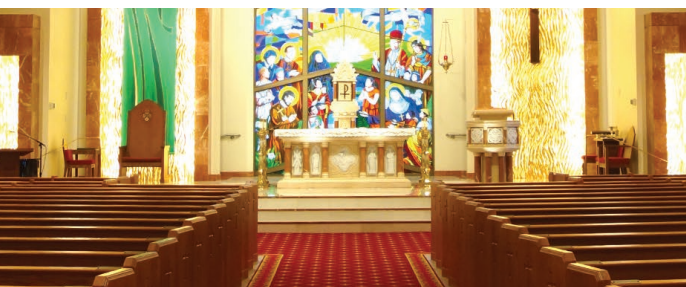

TIPS FOR ALL WORSHIPERS What to Expect



BEFORE YOU ARRIVE



Register to attend a specific Mass online or by calling the Parish office.



Check your temperature; if you have one, please do not come to church.



Stay home if you are ill or have been exposed recently to someone who is ill.



Make sure you have a face covering to bring and wear.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE



Enter only via designated doorways.



Wait patiently to be checked in by a greeter.



Keep your face covering on at all times (if you are over 2 years old) except for receiving Communion.



Sanitize your hands as directed by greeter.



Observe social distancing at all times (look for marks on the floor).



Ushers will direct you to pews with markings showing where to sit.



Use the sanitizing cloths at the end of the pew to sanitize your seat and kneeler.



Our ushers will pass the basket for your offering, but if you prefer, you may leave your offering in the boxes provided at the entrance and exit areas.

DURING THE SERVICE



Do not change seats during a service.



The offertory procession will be omitted.



No physical sign of peace will be exchanged during Mass.



Follow instructions for Communion:

- Ministers will not place their hands on the heads of persons not receiving Communion as a form of “blessing.”
- Leave your seat only when directed by an usher.
- Maintain six feet social distancing in the Communion line – look for marks on the floor.
- When 12 feet or two people away from the priest, sanitize your hands using the sanitizing station. After sanitizing, please do not touch your face or any surfaces.
- Approach the priest only after you are called forward. DO NOT remove your face covering.
- Extend a single hand to receive the Host.
- After moving six feet to the right or left, remove your face covering and consume the Host. You may not receive the Host with a gloved hand.
- Replace your face covering.
- Sanitize your hands using the sanitizing station in the aisle.
- Follow instructions to return to your pew.
